

Short term goals

Yes - Ensure short-term responses to pandemic don't undervalue work of members in the in the sector or replace permanent/ongoing roles

Yes - Adequately funded crisis services including crisis accommodation during pandemic response

Yes - Adequately resourced, skilled and supported staff across spectrum of homelessness services during surges in demand

Yes - Consultation with workers and ASU around housing pathways sector reform

Medium term goals

Yes - Ensuring all work that can be made permanent is and removal of sector-wide use of fixed term contracts

Yes - Build more public housing; 3,500 new public housing properties need to be built every year over the next 10 years (medium – long term)

Yes - More social housing properties with more parity in conditions and tenancy (medium-long term)

Yes - More crisis supported accommodation (regional concerns to be noted)

Long term goals

Yes - Increased community mental health supports, FV support, AOD etc and early intervention supports across the spectrum to avoid people entering homelessness service system

Yes - Increased ongoing supports for community members in public and social housing according to need

Yes - Adequate levels of skilled workforce to meet demand (medium-long term)

Yes - Classification parity across sector
